

ISCAS '94 will take place in the New Connaught Rooms conveniently located in the Covent Garden area in London's West End from May 30 to June 2, 1994. From here it's easy to walk to lots of cafes, bars, restaurants, theaters, shops and historic sites. Transportation by bus, taxi, underground and riverboat is easily reached.

Accommodations

High quality but inexpensive hotel accommodation within easy walking distance of the conference venue has been reserved for ISCAS '94 delegates and their friends.

Technical Programme

All the topics normally associated with ISCAS will be addressed by talks and posters as well as by keynote speakers, "birds-of-a-feather" meetings and a plenary session.

Tutorials

The first day, May 30, 1994, will be devoted to half- and full-day tutorials. Topics planned include Current

Mode Signal Processing, Sigma-Delta Converters, Smart Sensors, RF Design and Neural Networks.

The conference begins with an informal reception on the evening of May 30, 1994, and all delegates are invited to the conference banquet. Delegates' friends will be given an especially warm welcome as well as help about tourist activities.

ISCAS '95 UPDATE

The organizing committee of the 1995 ISCAS has been actively preparing for the meeting and most pre-conference activities are progressing smoothly. The Symposium will be held May 1-4, 1995, at the Sheraton Hotel & Towers in Seattle. The contract has been negotiated and approved, offering reasonable rates to attendees. The hotel is situated in downtown Seattle, close to numerous cultural, ar-

tistic, and tourist activities. The committee members have been identified since the original proposal submitted to CAS Society, and include Robert J. Marks II (General Chair - University of Washington), Mani Soma (Technical Program Chair - University of Washington), David Allstot (Special Sessions Chair - Carnegie Mellon University), Patricia Daniels (Local Arrangements Chair - Seattle University), Teck Seng Low (International Coordinator - National University of Singapore), Arnold Nordsieck (Exhibits Chair - Boeing Company), Jeng-Neng Hwang (Publications Chair - University of Washington), Mohamed El-Sharkawi (Publicity Chair - University of Washington), and Gregory Koskowich (Finance Chair - Resound Corporation).

The Technical Program Committee is considering several possible enhancements to

improve ISCAS according to the recommendations made by Ian Getreu's subcommittee in 1991. A four-page submission for review, instead of a short abstract, would help improve the paper quality; CD ROM publication of the symposium proceedings is being investigated; and arrangements are being made for electronic submission. The submission deadlines and topics have been established and published in flyers that were distributed at the 1993 ISCAS in Chicago. In the next few months, the program will take firmer shape, and we also expect to finalize arrangements for the Welcome Reception, the Plenary Session, and invited speakers.
