GREETINGS FROM THE TECHNICAL DIRECTOR

The idea of combining the major conferences of the IEEE Neural Networks Council into a single Congress was born in 1990. Originally, the World Congress on Computational Intelligence had 'Intelligent Systems' in place of 'Computational Intelligence'(CI) in its title. Recognizing that *Intelligent Systems* had a specific meaning in the AI community - a meaning not consistent with the contents of the Congress, James C. Bezdek, the current Vice President of Meetings of the NNC, suggested CI. CI is an apt description of the topical union of the three component conferences that comprise WCCI.

The WCCI concept serves many purposes. First, it reduces the number of conferences some of us feel obligated to attend each year. Secondly, it fosters cross fertilization of fields that are proving to be highly complementary. The idea of WCCI was noble - and risky. Putting the Congress together the WCCI is the overall responsibility of the Director General, Charlie Robinson. The proper way to address Charlie at WCCI is as General Robinson. Although rarely done, the Attorney General of the United States and the Surgeon General are correctly addressed as General. You now understand why some of us occasionally salute him.

Also to be congratulated are the three conference Chairs - Piero P. Bonissone of *The Third IEEE International Conference on Fuzzy Systems*, Zbigniew Michalewicz of *The IEEE Conference on Evolutionary Computation*, and Steven K. Rogers of *IEEE International Conference on Neural Networks*. Jacek Zurada has, for the first time along with the IEEE Neural Networks Council, coordinated a fantastic plenary symposium. I predict it will be the first of many. Karen Haines, as always, has done a magnificent job as Tutorials Chair.

The support from NNC President Patrick K. Simpson, Executive Vice President Walter Karplus and Past President Russell Eberhart (who was responsible for getting us the incredible Dolphin as the WCCI sight), was crucial.

Enjoy the Congress.
